- Awareness raising material, local level, with OECS linked to Saint Lucia national project
- Awareness raising material, high level started to work on it, need to link it to concrete event ABS CDI was at SIDS Summit, convened side-event
- Regional ABS web page ABS CDI web page opened in April 2014
- Quarterly Newsletter started, but stalled, not much news to be reported



Legal Framework

- Regulatory package work in progress, AUC ABS Guidelines finalised
- National support in Saint Lucia stalled due to funding issues
- National support to Bahamas GEF ABS project work is under way, now implementing PPG
- National support to Dominican Republic work is under way, 2 workshops on MAT and aTK
- Justice Institute Guyana & National Toshao Council workshop and study conducted



Legal Framework

- 3rd Caribbean ABS Workshop convened in November 2014
- Establishment of regional ABS guidelines, policies, model clauses, including MAT training to be discussed at this workshop MAT training scheduled for Q3 2015
