Research Permits for Terrestrial Environment

The Steps

- 1. MoU between Forestry and researcher, terms developed together.
- 2. Forestry provides an export permit if researcher request samples to go with. These samples could be whole specimens or body parts such as blood, or tissue. The Veterinary and Livestock Division s would also issue a permit in the case of animals (whether whole specimens or body parts).
- 3. If the species is listed in the CITES appendix Forestry will also issue a CITES permit.

The Steps cont'd

IF someone not conducting research wants to export samples or parts or individuals of a species listed in the CITES appendices, then only a CITES permit is issued.
