

•Parties to the Nagoya Protocol- KE ratified on 12.10.14; UG accession on same date

ABS regulatory framework in place in both countries



Landscape of the ABS regulatory frameworks generally (GR +aTK)- KE

Widely scattered across a range of statutes and regulations

Institutional arrangements- KE

Competent National Authority...functions not set out as clearly in the regulation (NEMA)

Focal point: Ministry of Environment





Institutional arrangements- UG

Competent National Authority- designation and functions clear (UNCST)

Focal point- NEMA





Exempted uses- KE

- Customary use and exchange by local communities for consumptive purposes
- Access to PGRFA
- Human genetic resources
- Approved research activities for academic purposes with recognized research and academic institutions





Exempted uses- UG

- Customary use and exchange by local communities for consumptive purposes
- Exchange purely for food and other consumptive purposes
- Access to PGRFA
- Human genetic resources
- Approved research activities for academic purposes with recognized research and academic institutions
- GRs in transit





Ownership and management of GRs- KE

Takes a custodian approach but less explicit

- Ownership not defined; management assumed across a wide range of statutes





Ownership and management of GRs- UG

- more explicit! Owner in relation to GRs is defined
 - Registered proprietor of land
 - Customary owner or occupier
 - Lessee, agent or trustee of the land
 - ■Person for the time being owning, using or benefiting from the GRs

very explicit!

"The right to determine, control and regulate access to GRs from Uganda is vested in the Government for the benefit of the people of Uganda..."
